Father Gartlan Trophy

Father Thomas Gartlan SJ was the founder of the St. Ignatius' College Rowing Club in 1882 and was its first Rowing Master. He was also Headmaster 1901 to 1911 and 1913 to 1919. Father Gartlan continued his keen interest in school rowing up to his death in 1942. This trophy was donated to the AAGPS in his memory by rowers of St. Ignatius' College Rowing Club in the Centenary Year of their Club (1982), for competition amongst the Third Fours.

After attending Sydney High School, Allan maintained a close association with the school and was involved in coaching rowing crews there. He coached the Sydney High Eight from 1957 to 1960 with victories in 1957 and 1959. He coached the Australian Eight which gained the Silver Medal at the Mexico Olympics. He coached the Australian Eight for the Munich Olympics. In recent years he also coached at St. Ignatius' College. Allan served in various offices of the NSWRA and as a State and National selector.

Yaralla Cup

Dame Edith Walker's name is well-known to generations of GPS oarsmen. Her large house (now a small hospital) at the end of Yaralla Bay marks the start of the old GPS mile-and-a-half course on the Parramatta River. In 1906, Dame Edith presented the handsome Yaralla Cup to the AAGPS for competition in the second crews (in those days, the 2nd IV). After the introduction of Vllls it became the much-prized trophy for the 1st IV event.

Saint Ignatius' College 1st V111, 2023 Winners of the Major Rennie Trophy

Major Rennie Trophy

Major Zenus C. Rennie was an American Civil War veteran who fought for the Union at Baton Rouge in 1862. He arrived in Australia to work for the Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York. In June 1893, Major Rennie's offer of a silver trophy was accepted by the AAGPS as a perpetual trophy for the major event of the Regatta.

From 1893 until 1935, the Regatta was held on the Parramatta River; from 1936 until 1996 on the Nepean River; and since 1996 at the Olympic Course. From 1893 until 1909 the race was contested by four-oared boats, and by eight-oared boats since then. Since 1996 the race has been contested over 2000 metres; all previous events were over a mile and a half, except in 1946 and 1947 when the races were over a mile and a quarter*.

1964 HEAD OF THE RIVER

1st IV and 1st VIII CREWS

It is our pleasure to warmly welcome the winning Saint Ignatius' College's 1st VIII and 1st IV crews from 1964 to attend this year's Head of the River, more than 60 years on from their historic victories on the Nepean.

They join us today, over half a century later, to once again step onto the podium to assist in the presentation of the 1st IV Yaralla Cup, and the 1st VIII Major Rennie Trophy to the winning 2024 crews.

1964 NSW GPS Head of the River - "40,000 See Riverview Win Race"

Riverview swept home by six lengths to win the 66th G.P.S. Head of the River on the Nepean at Penrith yesterday.

They beat Newington by that margin and left Shore yet another length behind. Officials agreed it was one of the easiest Head of the River wins ever. Riverview - who started as 5-2 underdogs - took the lead from the start and never let it go.

Newington, last year's winner and hot favourite for this year's race, could only cling to them. Nearly 40,000 people, mostly teenagers, screamed themselves hoarse as the eights came into view a couple of hundred yards from the finish. It was there that it was settled that River had the 1964 G.P.S. boat race tied up.

And it was then that hats, bunting, ribbons from the Riverview camp flew into the air. The Riverview crew shot through the water in 8m 4-5s over the mile and a half course - although they were rowing into a head wind.

THE G.P.S. ANNUAL REGATTA.

The *Sydney Morning Herald* puts it thus: "The Sydney Grammar School sprang another surprise on the rowing public by winning the Eights, after a hard tussle with the Church of England Grammar crew. "The School" is thus Head of the River for the third successive year. The official result was, Grammar by three-quarters of a length, with St. Joseph's three lengths away, third."

The sportsmaster at St. Ignatius ended his letter: "That the best crew won is beyond question and, although we should have liked very much to change places with the Grammar School in the race of the year, I trust we are sufficiently sportsmanlike to admit that we, like every other crew, deserved to come after them in what was undoubtedly one of the finest races ever seen on the Parramatta."

This spirit is very pleasant in G.P.S. rivalry; it is our strength and our justification. It is the business of all of us to see to it that, whatever our fortunes in the future, this generous friendliness last on among the boys and old boys of all the schools.

Yet another new school arrived to the event this year. This year it was Sydney High School who entered a crew in the Yaralla Cup and school - another first-time winner. They were the only GPS school not competing in this event. It is reported that High's application was welcomed by the other schools.
